## 2019 HVGS - Jabulani School Service Tour Africa

### Scholarship Application details

#### SELECTION PROCESS:

Students will follow a two-stage selection process:

**Stage 1** (Due Friday Week 3, Term 4 2018) – Students will submit a piece of work on a theme or topic that conveys their commitment to and understanding of ‘Service’.

Examples may include:

- Essay of 1000 words (word count does not include references or footnotes)
- Poem or short story
- Audio presentation (maximum 10 minutes)
- Video presentation (maximum 10 minutes)
- Musical composition – a song or instrumental
- Digital presentation
- Web page or PowerPoint
- Artwork – painting, drawing, photograph or textile

**Stage 2** (TBC)– A school/community panel will be established to consider the work submitted and shortlist students who will then be invited to present their work to the panel in an interview setting. Students can choose the work sample they submit to support their application. Students will also be required to demonstrate that they have the qualities and attributes to be an appropriate representative of HVGS at this important event. At the interview stage, students will be asked to discuss their work and how it relates to the topic that has been set.

The panel will be required to assess:

- The quality of the student’s submission and their presentation.
- Their capacity to undertake the tour.
- If they will be an appropriate representative of HVGS in the tour setting.
- Their ability to communicate effectively on his or her return (upon their return from the tour students will be expected to share their experiences with their school and the community).

## EMERGENCY REPLACEMENTS FOR STUDENTS

HVGS will establish a reserve list of one or two students who can replace the initial nominee in the event of emergency. These reserve students will need to be prepared to step in for the nominated student (e.g. they will need to have passports and have made other preparations as if they were going).

## SELECTION ELIGIBILITY

- All students enrolled in years 8-11 in 2018, will be eligible to apply for selection to go on the Jabulani School Service Tour in 2019.
- The name of the successful student will be announced in December 2018.

## THE SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT PRE AND POST TOUR COMMITMENTS

### Pre-Tour Commitments

#### Student:

- Will receive all flights, accommodation and tour fees as part of the Scholarship
- Will be responsible for funding their own spending money, meals (outside of those provided as per the itinerary) and any costs incurred prior to departure i.e. cost of passport and immunisations
- Is expected to attend all meetings leading up to the event
- Will be required to fundraise as part of the Jabulani team
- Will be expected to commit \$100 AU to sponsor the education of a child from the Jabulani School

### Post Tour Commitments

#### Student:

- Will complete a diary entry/log for the entirety of the tour to document their experience in School Service
- Produce a shortened report for Mr Teys and an HVGS publication. You will also be expected to present at an HVGS assembly
