Otherwise, permission must be granted by the Principal. The student must abide by the Code of Conduct. The Pass is not transferable to another person. The Pass must be presented on boarding the bus. Where a Pass is lost or stolen or damaged beyond recognition the student must contact the School Administration Office. A fee may be charged for the replacement of a lost, stolen or damaged Pass.
